

Troy Fair Demolition Derby (2008)
Truck class

Trucks are to remain stock unless otherwise noted. If it is not in the rules does not mean you can do it.

This will be a one heat class.

Class is open to ½ & ¾ ton pickups and suburban style vehicles. They are to be two wheel drive or four wheel drive with only one axle driving.

Body is to be stripped of all glass, chrome, trim, side mirrors, plastic and fiberglass panels. Windshields are not acceptable. Rubber body mounts may be removed. But must be replaced with flat washers.

Two steel bars must be mounted from the firewall to the roof.

Gas tanks must be mounted in the center of the bed near the cab, securely fastened down and covered with a metal shield. Tanks are to be of a fuel cell type five gallon maximum. All electric fuel pumps require a separate power switch within drivers reach. **Switch must be labeled fuel pump shutoff.** Homemade fuel cells must be: 1.sturdy 2.securely mounted 3.entirely leak proof or you cannot run. Fuel lines within passenger compartment and those that go through the body must be metal.

Frame – no alterations or reinforcements to the frame. Box can be welded to the cab 3” for every 10”.

Transmission – floor shifters are allowed

Brakes – must be in working order.

Bumpers are to remain stock height

Rears ends may be welded, no coil to leaf spring alteration.

Doors are to be chained or wired shut. Doors may be welded exterior seams only. You are allowed to use flat steel over the seams up to 3/16th thickness and 3” inches wide. If drivers door comes open vehicle will be disqualified.

Exhaust must extend beyond the driver’s seat or you may run stacks.

Fans no belt driven stock fans allowed, you may use an electric fan with plastic or nylon blades.

Hoods are to have a hole cut in it large enough to put out a fire if necessary, are to be wired shut after inspection.

Suspension – no modifications

Battery may be left under the hood or moved to the passenger side floor (must be held down securely and covered with a rubber mat).

Tires any auto or light truck tire allowed up to 8 ply rating. No farm or industrial tires allowed.

Anti-freeze is to be removed if not vehicle will be disqualified.

Rules can change if a situation arises that is deemed unsafe by the promoters or Troy Fair.
