

## TROY FAIR QUEEN PAGEANT

On Sunday night, July 20, 2008, the Troy Fair will be holding its annual Troy Fair Queen Pageant. This will be held at approximately 7:30 PM and it will take place in front of the grandstands. The Ribbon cutting will be held at 7:00 PM. The Troy Fair Queen will play a very important role at this year's fair. She will be the spokesperson for the entire fair. She will be hosting all the dignitaries, helping at the Ribbon cutting ceremonies, introducing our special guests, helping with the loud speaker announcements, will serve as a hostess to other Commodity Queens such as Dairy Princesses, Maple Sweetheart, special dedications, and the list goes on. She will represent the **WHOLE** fair.

After the fair, the Queen will be busy promoting the Troy Fair through radio, newspaper and possible television ads. She will also be attending parades, open houses at Fair Exhibitor businesses, and speaking to special interest groups about the Troy Fair. She will also compete in the State Fair Queen Pageant held during the month of January at the State Fair Convention. There are currently 54 other local fair queens in the state of Pennsylvania that compete for the state title. The 2006 Troy Fair Queen is Miss Jerikah Hite of Canton, PA. She is the daughter of Jon and Tammi Hite and is a junior at Canton High School.

The qualifications for the Troy Fair Queen are as follows:

1. Live in Pennsylvania.
2. Live in Bradford County or attend a school in Bradford County.
3. Be at least 16 years old before June 1, 2008 and not over 20 years old by June 1, 2008.
4. If under the age of 18, have parental/custodial consent.
5. Be single, never married, have no children, and must not marry or have a child during her reign.
6. Present a wholesome and healthy appearance.
7. Need not to be actively involved in agriculture, but must have a keen interest in promoting the Troy Fair as an agricultural fair.
8. You must write an essay, 300 words or less, entitled, "What the Troy Fair Means to Me!"
9. You **MUST NOT** hold another title/be a pageant winner for the current year.
