All rabbits need to arrive between the hours of 6:00 and 9:00 p.m. on Friday, July 28 or by 8:00 a.m. on Saturday, July 29th. All rabbits will need to stay until 5:00 p.m. on Saturday, July 29th.

Show Rules.

1. **All rabbits must be owned by the exhibitor by May 15, 2006. All entries are due at the Extension Office by June 16, 2006.**
2. All carriers must have a leak-proof bottom.
3. All rabbits must have a permanent mark in the left ear.
